

Tic-Tac-Toe Vocabulary Worksheet

Using the words below in the tic-tac-toe board you will write 6 sentences. Your focus on this activity is NOT to give the definition of the word, but to actually write sentences using the vocab word in a sentence. It sounds easy, but this activity will show me that you understand the meaning of the word and can actually use it in a sentence with other words.

Your words for this activity are:

Dog Red Ball House Cat Water Blue Bed Grass

The rules are:

- Your first sentence will use the words going down under number 1 (DOG, RED, BALL)
Ex. My dog played with the red ball outside
- Your second sentence will use the words going down under the number 2 (WATER, CAT, GRASS)
Ex. My cat was playing in the grass when it became thirsty and came inside for some water.
- Your third sentence will use the words under the number 3 (HOUSE, BED, BLUE)
Ex. I had to carry my bed up into my blue room in the new house I bought.
- Your fourth sentence will use the words next to the number 4 (DOG, WATER, HOUSE)
Ex. My dog spilled water all over the house!
- Your fifth sentence will use the words next to the number 5 (RED, CAT, BED)
Ex. My cat slept on my red shirt that was folded on my bed.
- Your sixth sentence will use the words next to the number 6 (BALL, GRASS, BLUE)
Ex. I kicked my blue ball in the grass at the park.
